



Dental Clinic - Leon County Health Department

The county health department runs the Dr. Edward F. Zapert Dental Clinic. It is also known as The Molar Express. The train themed facility provides dental services in a child friendly atmosphere. Services are available for Medicaid-eligible Florida residents. The care is from birth to age 20. All patients 17 and under must be supervised by a guardian at all times. The clinic is open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. It is closed on holidays. Please call or visit the [website](#) for more information.

- Diagnostic: Examinations, digital x-rays, biopsies
- Education: Presentations for schools, community groups, and health fairs
- Preventative: Prophylaxis (cleanings), fluoride treatments, sealants
- Restorative: Composite and amalgam restorations, stainless steel crowns
- Surgical: Extractions and emergency treatment
