This agency in Seminole County provides a safe, supportive and healing environment in which disadvantaged or homeless people receive the help they need to return to self sufficiency. They provide emergency food, shelter, clothing, and counseling. They have referral services so clients can find the resources they need through other agencies.

While here, clients can also get shelter, two meals a day and access to the clothes closet. They can also get spiritual guidance.

Rescue Outreach Mission aims to provide a pathway to stability to bridge the gap between homelessness to housing for individuals and families in Central Florida. They provide emergency resources such as food and shelter through two onsite shelters and a "Housing for Families" program. They also assist with clothing and counseling through access to comprehensive case management and referral services that help individuals find needed resources beyond those offered at the mission.

Rescue Outreach Mission was founded in 1986 by Mother Blanche Bell Weaver while she served as

pastor of the Rescue Church of God. Mother Weaver saw desperate people in her community living without the basic essentials and with the support of her church and its members she set out to help those in need. The mission now focuses on helping men and women return to self-sufficiency by providing transitional housing and case management.
