And are designed to help children with a variety of conditions and needs. Please call or visit the website for more information.

Services include:

- Child Protection & Safety - for infants, children, and adolescents who have been alleged to be abused or neglected
- Child & Family Information - for families seeking information about parenting, family care and support, and overall well-being of your child
- Early Intervention / Child Development - for eligible young children whose development is behind their peers and the families of those children
- Newborn Screening - for expectant parents and parents of newborn babies

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
